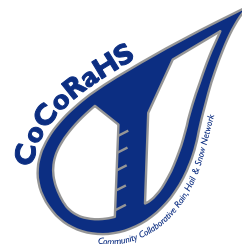

The National Weather Service in Spokane is seeking volunteers who would like to become official **Weather Spotters**.

Weather spotters are the “eyes and ears” of the NWS and provide valuable weather reports, which cannot be replaced.

The training is free to the public and prior experience is not necessary.

Those interested often include citizens, amateur radio operators, CERT and Citizen Corps personnel, law enforcement, fire, transportation and public works staff.



Information on the new Community Collaborative Rain, Hail and Snow Network (CoCoRaHS) will also be presented.

Spotter reports, coupled with radar, satellite, and other data, have enabled the NWS to issue more timely and accurate warnings and statements for many types of hazardous weather.
